BUSINESS COUNCILS

They are composed of members of our National Chambers and bring **experts** from business sectors to discuss **policy, regulation, and market access** and **engage with the Government** and other relevant stakeholders. The Business Councils research and study European-related **business, trade** and **investment** topics relevant to Hong Kong and Macau and the rest of the Greater Bay Area and **facilitate networking**.

European Automotive Council (EAC)



EAC represents the European passenger car and commercial vehicle manufacturers in Hong Kong. It aims to bring forward proposals and partner with Hong Kong's government, working together towards a safer, greener, more efficient and more competitive automotive sector.



Sustainable Finance Working Group (SFWG)
